ABRACHIA (Born with no arms)

ACROMEGALY (Elongation of the face and limbs caused by genetics. But it is precipitated by family dynamics.)

ADRENO-LEUKO DYSTROPHY (A.L.D.) [Loss of myelin sheaths in the brain in male children]

“ALBINO” (No pigmentation in the skin, eyes and hair)

BATTAN’S DISEASE (Neuronal Seroid Lypofufionis) [Genetic neural degenerative disease]

“BIRTH DEFECT(S)”

“BLUE BABY” (Born with an oxygen deficiency problem)

BONES -- DEFORMED

“BRITTLE BONES” SYNDROME (Extremely vulnerable to breakage)

“CLEFT PALATE” (Nasal passage and throat are joined)

“CLUB FOOT” (Congenitally misshapen)

“COLOR BLINDNESS”

CONGENITAL PROBLEMS (Present at birth due to heredity, intrauterine environmental factors and/or the birth process.)

“DEVIANT;” “DEFORMED” (As in hunchback, dwarf, “Elephant Man,” “Face,” etc.)

“DOWN’S SYNDROME” (Congenital retardation with “Mongolian-like” facial features)

EPICANTHRUS (Born with no eye socket muscles)

EXTRA FINGER(S) (Born with them)

EXTRA TOE(S) (Born with them)

“HARE LIP” (Rabbit nose-like markings and distortions of the upper lip)

“HUNCHBACK;” “HUMP BACK”

HYDROCEPHALIC BRAIN (Fluid-filled and very small brain, usually leading to profound retardation. However, there are people who lead near-normal lives with this condition. It is indicative of how we use very little of our actual brain potential.)

HYPO-SPADIS (Incomplete urethra at the end of the penis at birth)

ICHTHIOSIS (No oil glands and non-functioning sweat glands -- producing dry, scaly skin. It is genetically transmitted.)

INHERITED DISEASE(S)

KLEINFELTER SYNDROME (XXY genetic structure generating language-related learning disabilities, with speech delay, extreme shyness and small genitalia in some cases.)

“LOU GHERIG’S DISEASE” (Degeneration of the spinal cord and muscles)

NEURONAL SEROID LYPOFUFIONIS (Genetic neural degenerative disease)

PORPHYRIA (Hereditary unpredictably episodic metabolic disorder that precipitates temporary emotional and mental problems.)

PYLORIC STENOSIS (Closed off stomach entrance at birth)

SPINA BIFIDA (Non-joining of the basal vertebrate, resulting in a protruding of the spinal cord at birth)

TAY-SACHS DISEASE (A genetic fatal degeneration of the fetal nervous system present at birth.)
