This is a book about the parenting process -- what's involved, what's needed and what we know about it. It is composed of a series of essays. In general, this is not a "how to" book on how to go about the day-to-day management of the requirements on parenting.

It is instead a primer on how to *approach* the parenting process. It lays out a general framework for understanding what your child(ren) are doing and what you are doing as you go about living with, rearing, and launching your child(ren).

The whole thing is really about facilitating the destinies that your children come in with. This means that every interaction every day is about meeting the child's needs in a manner that they can then carry out the purposes that they came here with.

Because the topic is so huge and so multi-faceted, the book will be presented in sections dealing with different aspects of the process of coping with kids and in trying to make every moment count. Hopefully, it will be of assistance in this, the most important undertaking of your life.

The general sequence of topics will be about:

- 1) Focusing on their soul(s) as you parent them.
- 2) The developmental stage of parenting.
- 3) The process of parenting in the early formative period.
- 4) The ages 3 to 7 parenting period.
- 5) The role requirements of fathering.
- 6) The role of erotic parameters in parenting.
- 7) Child care in the coming world.
- 8) The new soul pools coming in.
- 9) The problematic parenting patterns dictionary.
